I hope you and your family had a lovely Easter. I am really looking forward to getting back into the swing of school life as we start our final term together.

Our Topic this term is 'on the move' and this term's Science topic is animals including humans. Information about the learning we will be doing this term can be found on the Summer Term Curriculum Overview. In Year 1, we have early morning learning activities before registration so it is important that your child is present and on time each morning.

This term P.E. will be on Tuesdays and Fridays. Children will still be required to attend school in PE Kit on these days. Please ensure that your child has appropriate P.E. kit. We will be doing Gymnastics in PE on a Friday meaning children will need their indoor kits (a plain white T-shirt, shorts for inside pumps for indoors). Please also be aware that, for health and safety reasons, earrings must be removed for P.E and that anyone with hair longer than shoulder length should have their hair tied back.

Children will continue with Forest School and outdoor PE on a Tuesday, so please ensure that they have long sleeves and trousers / leggings with them (forest school clothes could be left at school for the half term).

Please can children bring a named bottle of water to drink during the day and ensure that all uniform is named.

Children will once again be sent home with their home learning grid containing optional activities. In addition, children will be expected to read at least 3 times a week- please remember to record this in their diaries. To move up our reading challenge, children will need to read 4 times a week. Children will also be given a weekly phonics/ spelling sheet which can be found on your child's STARZ account. They will not be tested on these words but it would be beneficial to your child to practise them. To support your child in their Maths, they have access to Numbots which they should played for at least 30 minutes a week.
