Buttercups class assembly

Bikes and scooters

With the arrival of summery weather, a lot of children are travelling to and from school on bikes and scooters. This is a great way to travel and we encourage children to cycle and scoot as much as possible. However, for the safety of everyone, we do have a very sensible rule of no cycling or scooting on the school grounds. Children whizzing around on the playgrounds risk knocking others over and we have to think of everyone's safety. Please make sure your child gets off and pushes their bike as soon as they are in the school gate. This applies to preschool children too, so we are asking parents to get good habits started early. It also applies to adults!

Playground equipment before and after school

We have noticed that especially in Key Stage 1 children are playing on the playground equipment before and after the school day. We would remind you that there are notices up in both playgrounds, stating that this equipment should only be used when school staff are supervising the children – in other words it's only for school playtimes. We are particularly concerned for preschool children, who are too little to be playing safely on the apparatus and will be tempted if other children are on there. For all their safety, please don't allow your children to use the school equipment during waiting times.

Church Days - 24th and 25th May

We have our annual Church Days coming up just before half-term (see diary section below). Reverend Petra has lots of exciting ideas for activities and it

would be fantastic if some parent volunteers were available to help on one of those mornings, supporting the activities and accompanying the children to St John's church.
