Dear Parents and Carers

This is the first Airwaves of the new school year. For our new families, this is the letter that appears each Friday, and is full of useful news and information. The newsletter is sent out by email and is also uploaded onto the school website. Please read it carefully!

A warm welcome back to all our children and families after the summer break. It has been great to see the children looking smart and ready to come back to their learning. The teachers have been busy planning lots of exciting things for the new school year - they will be talking about their plans at the class meetings next week (see below).

A special welcome to our new Reception children in Buttercups and Daffodils classes and to Matthew who is joining Year 6.

We are delighted to welcome 4 new members of staff to our team this year. These are Miss Lucy Nicholson teaching in Daffodils, Miss Emma Dyson, teaching in Doves, and Miss Abigail Clarke teaching across years 3 and 4. We also welcome a new cleaner, Dianne Dellar. Lionel Beard has been promoted to Site Officer and is responsible for all 3 of the cleaning staff, two of whom have transferred to school staff from CCS.

We also very pleased that our parishes have a new vicar, Reverend Petra Shakeshaft, who has been in to see us this week and will be coming into school regularly from next week.

You will remember that our school had applied to become a teaching school. Disappointingly we were not successful, however, we are delighted to continue with our partnership with the Faculty of Education, Cambridge and Histon and Impington Teaching Alliance, who provide us with PGCE and SCITT students for our experienced teachers to coach and mentor. Our school receives funding for this. I will continue to work for Ely Diocese as an advisor to schools and also as part of the Teach in Cambs team promoting ways of recruiting and retaining teachers in Cambridgeshire. Again, our school receives funding for this time.
