Christmas dinner – Thursday 15 December

The cook needs numbers for this meal well in advance and this year's menu is given below. This year, to make things simpler, we are going to put all Reception and Key Stage 1 children in for a Christmas dinner. If on the day your child would rather bring a packed lunch, that's fine.

For Key Stage 2 children, the Christmas dinner is the normal price of £2.25. We are going to assume that all the children will have the dinner unless we hear otherwise from you. So you need to opt out of the dinner by contacting the office rather than opting in as in previous years. So far the office have had only two opt outs - please let us know by Tuesday 6 December if your child does not want the Christmas Dinner. Please also let the office know if your child wants the vegetarian option. The meal needs to be paid for, ideally via Parentpay, by 15th December.

Please do not bring children under secondary school age to the evening performance - younger siblings are welcome at the morning performance. If you or you relatives require special seating arrangements for either performance, please could you let the school know in advance so that we can organise this. Parking will be available on the Key Stage 2 playground for the performances.
