English</u> Have a go at 2 Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar revision mats (available on Starz).</p> <p> There are 3 different difficulties so choose either the 1-star, 2-star or 3-star challenge (<i>see bottom left of sheet</i>).</p> <p>You must hand in 2 completed revision mats (one with the number 1 in the right-hand corner, one with a 5 in the RH corner).</p>	<p><u>3. Topic</u> Research Martin Luther King.</p> <p>Find out 5 facts about him and rewrite them in YOUR own words (not just copied and pasted from a website).</p> <p>You could present these facts on a poster, as a leaflet or in a PowerPoint.</p>	<p><u>6.Science</u> Research and create an information poster, pop-up book, video or model about the life cycle of an insect that undergoes metamorphosis.</p> <p>They might go through incomplete metamorphosis, like a stick insect, or complete metamorphosis, such as a caterpillar.</p>	<p><u>7. Topic: Art</u> Look at collages by Henri Matisse, such as <i>The Sorrows of the King</i>. Use cut out paper shapes to create your own Henri Matisse inspired collage.</p>	<p><u>8. PSHE: RSE</u> Imagine a child has written to you because they are worried about the changes they will experience during puberty.</p> <p>Write a letter replying to them, offering them some advice.</p>
