English</u> Write a free verse poem based on an emotion - such as sadness, happiness, anger, jealousy, etc.</p> <p>You may find this easier to do mid-way through the half-term when we start learning about this in class.</p>	<p><u>3. Maths/Art</u> Create a poster which demonstrates how to convert mixed numbers to improper fractions, and back the other way.</p>	<p><u>4. Maths</u> After finishing our unit on fractions, answer the following questions using bar models to show your working:</p> $\frac{3}{8} + \frac{3}{8}$ $\frac{5}{6} + \frac{1}{6}$ $\frac{9}{7} - \frac{4}{7}$
<p><u>5. Topic</u> Create a recipe book filled with healthy meals.</p> <p>Write instructions for making your meals and write a review for the dishes to <u>explain why</u> these meals are good for you or the positive impact they have on your <u>health</u>.</p>	<p><u>6. Science</u> Design and draw an electrical circuit (using the correct scientific symbols).</p> <p>It must include at least 1 bulb, 1 buzzer and 1 switch.</p> <p>Use the 'electrical circuit symbol mat' available on the school website.</p>	<p><u>7. PE</u> Plan a fitness workout and test it out.</p> <p>What muscles have you used? How does your heart rate change throughout the fitness workout? How will this workout help you to stay healthy?</p>	<p><u>8. PSHE/Topic</u> After our PSHE lessons on smoking, write a letter which explains to someone the dangers of smoking.</p>
