


















Write a poem about a crunchy red apple.

My brother is as silly as a monkey My sister is as loud as a lion But I sneak around the house I am a stealthy tiger.






Write a story using this as the first sentence: I crept carefully into the cellar and realised that there was something down there, waiting for me.
