Grandparents' Day - Friday 24 November

Our annual Grandparents' Day is coming up fast - one of the highlights of the year. Following the resounding success of this event in previous years, we are organising the day into two sessions, to enable as many grandparents as possible to attend. There is a choice of 10.45-11.45 am or 1.15-2.15 pm. Grandparents will be able to visit children in their classes, enjoy some singing and have a cup of tea or coffee. The Key Stage 2 playground will be open for parking for both sessions.

The children will be writing and sending their own invitations to grandparents next week. As in previous years if grandparents are not able to make it can they email or write a letter saying what they are doing on that day. Any photos are always welcome. All of this is shared with the class and then used as a display. We are aware that not all grandparents are still with us so if children want to bring photos in to share, that would be lovely. In past years we have found that the grandparents visiting are very sensitive and inclusive to the children who haven't got grandparents visiting.

This event is just for grandparents - I'm sorry but we are not able to accommodate any other family members, including parents and younger children. This is because it is a special day just for grandparents to celebrate their grandchildren's work and spend time in school with them.

Flu vaccinations

Some parents have expressed concern that our children (Years R-4) will not be vaccinated until 13 December. We have contacted the vaccination team and they have offered the following reassurance:

The Flu vaccination programme runs from 1st week of October (vaccine availability dependent) to December and this is because the main problem with the influenza virus is from January onwards. The idea is to get as many people, children and adults in risk groups, vaccinated before Christmas. So they have had a chance for their body to convert the vaccine into immunity before the main flu season starts. Please pass on our assurances that being vaccinated in December is not too late.

Consent letters about the vaccinations will go out at the end of November.
