## Literacy

#### Listening

To maintain attention and sit quietly, listening to others, during appropriate whole class and group activities. **Understanding** 

-To follow simple instructions.

-To talk about the main events in a story.

- -To make predictions about what will happen next in a story.
- -To talk about the main characters in a story.
- -To talk about the feelings of the characters
- -To learn about the difference between a character and a setting.

#### Speaking

- -To take turns when in a group or whole class session to talk.
