Challenges- Imagine you get lost on your island. Write a message in a bottle explaining what happened and how you need help. Write about what you can see, hear and how you feel.

Talk about what the words subtraction and take away means. How is this different to adding? What happens to the value of the number? Look at examples using your toys.

Can you find one less from different numbers your parent/carer calls out?

Practise counting back from different numbers E.g.

15,14,13,12,11. 8,7,6,5,4,3 etc
