## Maths

Talk about what the words subtraction and take away means. How is this different to adding? What happens to the value of the number? Look at examples using your toys.

15,14,13,12,11. 8,7,6,5,4,3 etc

Draw 5 long snakes and then on each of their skins draw a different repeating pattern from their heads to the tails. Can you make each one harder? E.g. use three colours or have a harder combination of colours, shapes or numbers?
