

#### Curriculum

- · Core subjects Maths and English
- These are taught daily. They may link with Topics and Science, but the basic skills are taught separately.
- Children will be given general writing targets (capital letters, full stops, finger spaces), but will have individual English targets to work on.
- · Science topic or block taught.

#### Phonics

Phonics is taught in ability groups tailored to children's individual needs, regardless of age. These may change throughout the year.

There are four 20 minute phonics sessions a week.



# Spelling

- Children will be sent home the sound/s that they will be learning in their phonics sessions to investigate and practise at home.
- A list of Common Exception Words will also be sent home with a focus on learning to spell three words each week which will be checked in school.



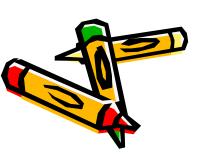
## Guided Reading

- Each child is heard to read by an adult at least once a week as part of a group
- Grouped with children working at a similar level, regardless of age.
- Individual reading should be done at home at least three times a week. Ask questions to check comprehension. Record when you have read with your child in their reading record diaries.
- Reading challenge grid in back of books to encourage deeper learning.
  - Books may be changed daily.



## Home Learning

- Daily reading (three times a week at least)
- Home learning grid so pupils can select their piece of topic work. (A project each term)
- Home Learning books to record anything done at home - Put in 'Home Learning Tray' in class to be marked as and when things are completed.
- Times tables- given out fortnightly to Year 2 children on a Friday.
- Times table check given on the second Wednesday.



#### Maths at home

#### Areas of Maths to cover at home:

- Time Analogue and digital half past, quarter to/past, 5 minute intervals
- Money coin recognition, making amounts using different coins, note recognition, giving change
- Measure Weight, length/height, capacity e.g home baking

Times tables practice - songs



# Reading Bookmark Rewards

To encourage reading at home, children will be given a sticker to put on their bookmark every time they read at home and it is recorded in their reading diary.

Once each bookmark is complete with stickers, it will be laminated and sent home to use as their own bookmark.



### Topics


- Topics are planned across Key Stage 1, each teacher uses learning objectives and activities appropriate to the different year groups.


#### Creative Carousel

 Inform the office if there are changes to the usual routine such as going home with a friend or a family member we do not know.




#### Bus

- For safety, we will keep children in school if bus arrangements are unclear so that the other children can leave on time.


# Enhancing the curriculum
