Children will sit the Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar test Monday, Reading test Tuesday, Maths Arithmetic and Reasoning paper 1 Wednesday and Reasoning paper 2 on Thursday. Please ensure your child is punctual, well rested and has had a good breakfast prior to the tests.
