Dear Parents and Carers

School meals and Pupil Premium

We have had a bit of a challenge this week in the kitchen as one of our vital pieces of cooking equipment - the steam oven - decided to break down on Monday morning and could not be repaired. Thanks to the resourcefulness of our catering staff, lunches have been served this week with a minimum of change to the menu, but if your child has mentioned a couple of changes, that will be why. Thankfully a wonderful new, all-singing, all-dancing combination oven was installed yesterday so we're back on track. The Autumn Term menu is attached again with Airwaves - there are dates at the bottom that clarify which week is which and we've added colours to make it clearer which meal is which.

We are noticing that there is already quite a bit of debt building up on school meals, particularly for those children who have moved into Year 3. We're sorry, but free school meals are only for children in Buttercups, Bluebells and Sunflowers classes (as well as those registered for free school meals in KS2). Payments for all other children should be made online via Parentpay. Please contact Mrs Rigby in the office if you need login details.

We would strongly encourage you to check out whether your child is eligible for free school meals (a form is attached with this Airwaves) - and to apply even if they get free meals at the moment anyway. There are lots of other benefits to being registered for free school meals, including help with school trips and after-school clubs.
