# Nativity performances – Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> and Thursday 6<sup>th</sup> December

Tickets are coming home soon for this year's Nativity play, *Lights, Camel, Action.* All performances are entry by ticket only. There are a total of **4 free tickets per family** and you can choose which performance you would prefer. Tickets have been allocated on a first come first served basis. Please do not bring children under secondary school age to the evening performance - younger siblings are welcome at the morning performance. All Key Stage 2 children will have seen the Nativity in school, as will Preschool children, and the DX Club are opening specially (and for free) for anyone that needs childcare for their school-aged children. Please note - there should be no children sitting on laps and everyone should be seated, not standing at the back. This is because of fire regulations.

If you or you relatives require special seating arrangements for either performance, please could you let the school know in advance so that we can organise this. Parking will be available on the Key Stage 2 playground for the performances.

### Christmas cards

There will be a special post box in the foyer from Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> December where children can post cards to each other. The mail will be distributed each day by Year 6.
