Lunchtime clubs

We also run lunchtime clubs to provide opportunities for all the children. On Monday there will be a new club starting – a tennis club, run by a professional tennis coach called Ali McGee. Information and the cost of this club are shown on the attached poster. Numbers are limited on a first come, first served basis so let the office know if your Key Stage 2 child wants to take up this opportunity.

Other lunchtime clubs are Chess Club on a Friday, Basketball on a Tuesday (Cambridge Utd), Eco-Club on a Monday and Book Club on a Friday, as well as Homework Club twice a week. These clubs are run by school staff and volunteers and are free. Again, they are just for Key Stage 2 children.

It is next Thursday morning at 9.05 am and you are invited to pop down to the classroom after the assembly so your child can show you what they have been learning.
