Include answers.</p> <p>Eg. 798 (First Viking raid on Lindisfarne)<br/>1001 (Leif Erikson discovers America)</p> <p><b>Word problem:</b> Leif Erikson discovers America + First Viking raid on Lindisfarne = 1001 + 798</p> |
